Dear Friends. I love that Be the Gift has always been a carrier of hope and life as we continue to serve Widows, Single Moms, and their Children in our communities. Chris, our former Executive Director once said that heroes aren't people with giant statues in a town square, but people who embrace their community and find a way to make it better, in the moment when it is needed most. The ladies we are privileged to serve struggled with big need for assistance in 2022. In this last year alone, Be the Gift volunteers served over 2800 hours in our community, we gifted 7 single working mothers with college scholarships to further their education, we honored 85 Single Moms and their children with Christmas gifts and luncheon and served over 80 Single Moms with home repair assistance. It saddens me to say that in 15 years, I have never witnessed a Single Mom's financial situation in such a difficult state. An average two income family is

reeling and adjusting to the current economy and drastic rise in the cost of living, yet for a one income single mom who was barely meeting her bills and responsibilities in raising her children to improve and maintain her home is unrealistic and we are witnessing firsthand the consequences to these families. The good news is we are staffed and equipped with volunteers ready to help and are available to step into their homes with respect and compassion, listen to their story and their immediate needs and provide a solution. This is where we see our work and mission come about in an even larger way.

- SINGLE MOM STATS -

- According to 2021 U.S. Census Bureau, 4 out of about 11 million single parent families with children under the age of 18, nearly 80 percent were headed by single mothers.
- Only one third of single mothers received any child support, and the average amount these mothers received was only about \$286 a month.
- Almost one third of single mother families were "food insecure," and about one-ninth used food pantries, one third spent more than half their income on housing, which is generally considered the threshold for "severe housing cost burden."

We prayed and encouraged her; she thanked us many times and went on to explain how she could never repay us for all that we had done for her. One of our volunteers helping that day simply said, "YOU JUST DID."


